

Spellingframe Terms and Conditions

Operated by Mathsframe Limited

1. Introduction

These Terms and Conditions govern the use of Spellingframe, operated by Mathsframe Limited. By accessing or using Spellingframe, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. If you do not agree to these Terms, you should not use the service.

2. Definitions

- "Spellingframe" refers to the online spelling platform and associated services provided by Mathsframe Limited.
- "School" means the educational establishment purchasing or using a subscription.
- "User" means any individual accessing Spellingframe, including administrators, teachers and pupils.
- "Subscription" means a paid licence granting access to premium features of the service.

3. Licence to Use the Service

Mathsframe Limited grants users a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable licence to use Spellingframe in accordance with these Terms. Access is provided solely for educational purposes.

Users may not:

- Share subscription access outside the licensed school;
- Copy, reproduce or redistribute substantial portions of the content;
- Attempt to reverse engineer, modify or interfere with the operation of the service;
- Use the service for unlawful purposes.

4. School Subscriptions

A school subscription permits authorised staff and pupils within the subscribing school to use the premium features included within the subscription. Subscriptions are specific to the subscribing school and may not be transferred to another organisation. The subscription remains active for the period purchased.

5. Accounts and Security

Schools are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of account credentials issued to their staff and pupils. Users must not knowingly share account access with unauthorised individuals. Mathsframe Limited reserves the right to suspend accounts where misuse, unauthorised access or security concerns are identified.

6. Intellectual Property

All content available through Spellingframe, including software, text, graphics, activities, assessments, design elements and educational materials, remains the property of Mathsframe Limited unless otherwise stated. No content may be copied, republished, distributed or commercially exploited without prior written permission. The purchase of a subscription does not transfer ownership of any intellectual property rights.

7. Availability of Service

Mathsframe Limited aims to provide reliable access to Spellingframe. However, uninterrupted availability cannot be guaranteed. We may suspend access temporarily for maintenance, security updates, technical improvements or emergency repairs. Mathsframe Limited shall not be liable for temporary interruptions beyond its reasonable control.

8. Changes to the Service

Mathsframe Limited reserves the right to modify, update, improve or discontinue any feature, content or part of the service at any time. We may also introduce new features, pricing structures or subscription options. Where changes materially affect subscribers, reasonable notice will normally be provided.

9. Fees and Payments

Subscription fees are payable in accordance with the pricing displayed at the time of purchase. Payments are processed securely by Opayo or other authorised payment providers. Mathsframe Limited does not store payment card details. Failure to pay subscription fees may result in suspension or termination of access to premium services.

10. Data Protection and Privacy

The handling of personal data is governed by the Spellingframe Privacy Notice. Schools remain responsible for the pupil information entered into the platform. Mathsframe Limited processes such information on behalf of schools in accordance with applicable data protection legislation.

11. Limitation of Liability

Nothing within these Terms excludes liability where exclusion is not permitted by law. To the maximum extent permitted by law, Mathsframe Limited shall not be liable for indirect or consequential losses, loss of profits, loss of data arising from events outside our reasonable control, or temporary interruption of service. The total liability of Mathsframe Limited in connection with a subscription shall not exceed the amount paid for that subscription during the preceding twelve months.

12. Termination

Mathsframe Limited may suspend or terminate access where these Terms are breached, subscription fees remain unpaid, or continued access presents a security or operational risk. Schools may cease using the service at any time. Termination does not affect rights or obligations accrued before termination.

13. Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. Any disputes arising from these Terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.

14. Changes to These Terms

Mathsframe Limited may update these Terms and Conditions from time to time. The latest version will always be available through the Spellingframe website. Continued use of the service after changes have been published constitutes acceptance of the revised Terms.
