Data we store

- Name and address of school
- Name and email address of every teacher registered for a class
- Student's names (if provided), their class, their spelling group (if provided) and their spelling scores for each test that they take

Providing the names of children is not necessary (you could use their initials) but it makes them easier for you to identify when viewing test results.

Every child registered has a username and password automatically generated.

The children's scores for their spelling tests can be viewed by their teacher and by the school administrator (the person that set up the account). This information is not shared publicly and will never be shared with third parties.

You have the right to be forgotten. We will delete your personal data upon request.
